A **Minor in Graphic Design** is suggested for any student whose future endeavors may involve the creation or implementation of visual communications. The graphic design minor would complement a major in business, marketing, finance, computer science, criminal justice, communication arts (television, journalism, etc.), natural sciences and psychology.

The computer provides the technique, but the educated and imaginative organization of elements into arresting and compelling communication requires the skills of a trained designer.
