## **STAC HOLDS INFO SESSION FOR RETURNING AND TRANSFER STUDENTS**

**(SPARKILL, NY –March 31, 2008)** – St. Thomas Aquinas College will host an Information Session for individuals interested in returning to St. Thomas Aquinas to finish their undergraduate degree on Wednesday, April 9 from 2pm to 6pm.

St. Thomas Aquinas provides a convenient opportunity for students looking to reenter the college community to finish their degree. Mini-sessions in May, June, and July are available to help those looking to get a jumpstart on completing their college education. Summer sessions feature convenient evening and online courses for those students who work full time. In addition to traditional course offerings, eligible individuals who work in their field of study can earn “life experience credits” towards the completion of their degree.

The session will also focus on those students interested in transferring to the College to complete their degree. There are academic transfer scholarships available for students who show academic excellence and are interested in starting at St. Thomas in the Fall 2008. Scholarships are typically reserved for students who have excellent academic credentials from the College or University they previously attended. In many cases students are graduating from a two-year program, but in other cases, students would like to return to Rockland County to continue and complete their undergraduate studies.
