ST. THOMAS INTRODUCES LOUIS MUGGEO, PSY. D. AS NEW DIRECTOR OF COUNSELING SERVICES

(SPARKILL, NY – OCTOBER 27, 2008) – St. Thomas Aquinas College has appointed Dr. Louis Muggeo to Director of Counseling Services, announced Dr. Walter Schneider, the College's Vice President and Dean of Student Affairs. Dr. Muggeo joined the college staff at the beginning of the Fall semester.

Dr. Muggeo, a St. Thomas alumna, graduated in 1998 with a B.S. in Psychology. He earned an M.A. in Clinical Psychology from Fairleigh Dickinson University and a Doctorate of Clinical Psychology from Long Island University and is a licensed clinical psychologist. Previously, Dr. Muggeo served as full time professor of psychology at Bergen Community College and an adjunct professor in psychology at STAC. He is also currently a consulting psychologist for Abbot House.
