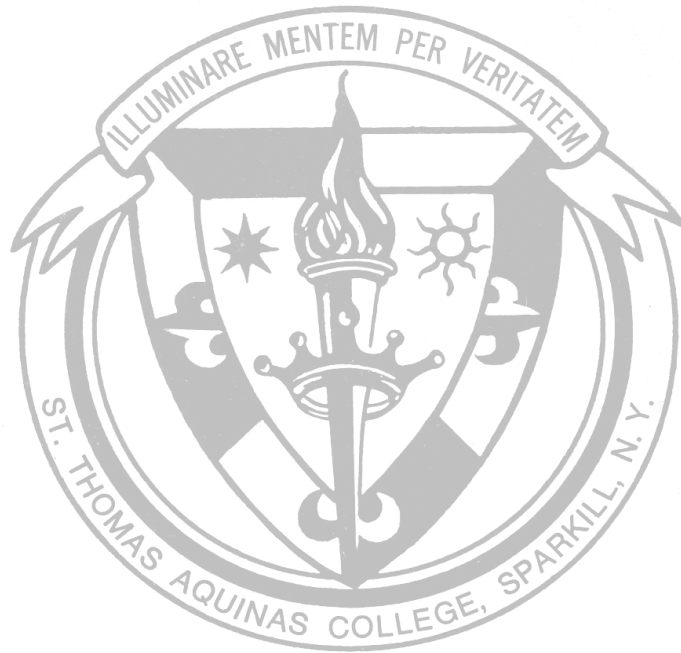

Mary Wadsworth Darby

Chief Representative of CKGSB Americas

Mary Wadsworth Darby helps identify CKGSB Americas strategic initiatives and build brand awareness of the business school in the U.S., Canada, and Latin America. She works closely with all the CKGSB centers to strengthen cross-marketing and program development. Mary also works with CKGSB partner schools with which CKGSB collaborates in response to changes in market dynamics and trade and capital flows.

Previously, Mary worked for Morgan Stanley in Firm Management and headed the Asia and China Desks. She moved to HK and headed Morgan Stanley Investment Management (MSIM) in Hong Kong and developed the first institutional sales initiative with Chinese financial entities. At Morgan Stanley, she also created and ran a series of educational programs for the fixed income division and other departments with a focus on China.

Mary has worked extensively in China and Asia for over 30 years. She founded Peridot Asia Advisors, a strategic transaction advisory firm. She has substantial experience negotiating market entry strategies over a broad range of industries, as well as with Chinese financial institutions, state-owned enterprises, regulatory authorities and other government entities responsible for regulating and supervising the insurance and banking industries.

She also served as the Executive Director of the America-China Society, a non-profit organization devoted to the promotion of US-China relations chaired by former US Secretaries of State Henry Kissinger and the late Cyrus Vance and traveled regularly to China with them for meetings with leaders. Previously, she held senior management positions including at Chase Manhattan Bank at Chase Pacific Trade Advisors, Allis-Chalmers, and Allied Chemical. Mary graduated with a BA degree from Princeton University. A fluent Mandarin speaker, she also holds an MBA from Columbia Business School and an MIA from the Columbia School of International and Public Affairs. She serves as a Senior Professional Fellow at the Chazen Institute at Columbia Business School. She serves as an Independent Director of the Industrial and Commercial Bank of China (ICBC, USA), whose parent company is the world's largest bank. She is also a member of the Council on Foreign Relations. Formerly, she served as the Chair of the Hong Kong Association of New York, Trustee of Concord Academy, Trustee of Princeton-in-Asia, among others.

She is married to Lawrence A. Darby, III, a lawyer. She has twins, Abigail Darby Robinson and Lawrence A. Darby, IV. She lives in Tuxedo Park, New York.

Mary Wadsworth Darby is the recipient of the honorary Doctor of Commercial Science.

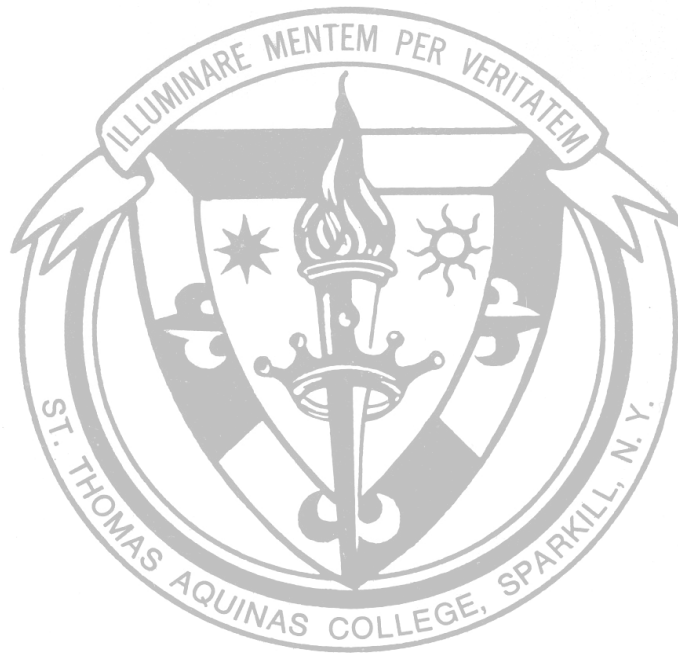

St. Thomas Aquinas College has expanded its offerings to include a Master of Science in Education, a Master of Science in Teaching, and a Post Masters Certificate in Education. The College offers a Master of Business Administration program, including an Online MBA program, a Master of Public Administration in Criminal Justice Administration, a Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Science in Education, and an Associate of Arts and an Associate of Science degree, the latter two offered at the United States Military Academy at West Point, NY. St. Thomas Aquinas College is also the host for a Master of Science in Social Work offered by New York University.

The College enrolls approximately 2,000 full and part time students. Undergraduates enroll in over 100 programs offered in three schools: The School of Arts & Sciences; The School of Business; and The School of Education. The College offers a 70% tuition scholarship Honors Program which usually provides students with a Summer Study experience at Oxford University in England which has been halted at this time until conditions are safe. In addition, there are several study abroad opportunities and strategic alliances designed to offer expanded opportunities for students.

When safe, St. Thomas Aquinas College offers study abroad in Ireland, Italy, Hungary, France, Spain, Canada, England, Brazil, and Japan. The College's 72-acre campus includes modern buildings and classrooms. The College's newest administrative and academic buildings feature state-of-the-art classrooms, faculty offices for business and education, and executive offices. The Spartan Athletic Complex facility hosts our women's softball, lacrosse and men's and women's soccer programs and serves as a practice facility for several activities year-round.
